These anti-Semitic screeds were kept afloat for decades by America’s godfather of hate-Louis Farrakhan. In 2022, one man, rapper Ye (Kanye West) used his unparalleled social media influence to morph these historic tropes into a firestorm of real-time anti-Semitism—absorbed by millions, and inspiring acts of hate against Jews—living and dead.

Ye delivered or shared anti-Semitic conspiracies to a social media following of tens of millions. That led to **a Dave Chappelle wink and nod to millions of viewers on NBC’s Saturday Night Live**. Kyrie Irving’s tweet shared a promotion of an anti-Semitic movie with his 22.5 million social media followers. The slanders against Jews was then defended, supported and reinforced by hundreds of thousands, including, white supremacists and extremists among Black Hebrew Israelites (See #9).

West’s next contribution to mainstreaming and expanding anti-Semitism came when he had dinner with former President Trump along with extreme right activist Nick Fuentes. Mr. Trump failed to condemn Fuentes or fully explain why he met with Kanye West who was running amok with anti-Semitic vitriol, **until he was pushed to do so by his former Vice President, Mike Pence and others**. By then the damage had been done.

Major social media platforms could have moved quickly to block the tsunami of hate based on their own terms of usage, but by and large they chose not to.

2 UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL

Diplomatic onslaught comparing Israel to Nazis, delegitimizing Jewish State, legitimizing Palestinian Terrorism



The demonization of Israel and normalization of anti-Semitism by diplomats involved with the Middle East continues to escalate without being held accountable by the United Nations.

Italian lawyer Francesca Albanese was appointed earlier this year as the **UN Special Rapporteur on the Situation of Human Rights in the Palestinian Territories**. Albanese is a walking anti-Israel encyclopedia and has spouted anti-Semitic screeds including that the “Jewish lobby” ran the United States. Albanese has expressed open sympathy for Palestinian terrorist groups, accused “oppressor” Israel of potential war crimes, compared Israel to Nazi Germany and legitimizes what she calls Palestinian “resistance.”

US Ambassador Michèle Taylor denounced Albanese’s trail of hate, “We are appalled by recently uncovered anti-Semitic remarks on social media made by a UN Human Rights Special Rapporteur before taking on the role. References to the ‘Jewish Lobby’ are age-old tropes; this is outrageous, inappropriate, corrosive, and degrades the value of the UN.”

US Ambassador Michèle Taylor denounced Albanese’s trail of hate, “We are appalled by

To date no action has been taken by the UN to sanction or remove Albanese from this sensitive post.

The UN has also failed to deal with a trio of diplomats in charge of a new open-ended anti-Israel Commission of Inquiry (COI) of the UN Human Rights Council.

In October the UN’s open-ended Commission of Inquiry released a report accusing the Jewish state - among other things - of discrimination against its Arab citizens and gender-based violence against Palestinian women.

The diplomats in charge said they would **investigate charges that Israel is an apartheid state, and dismissed Israel’s security concerns as “fiction”**. The three-member commission includes; **Miloon Kothari**, who has railed against the “Jewish lobby” and even questioned Israel’s inclusion in the UN, **Navi Pillay**, whose record of statements singling out Israel for alleged war crimes and human rights violations is legendary, and **Chris Sidoti**, an Australian lawyer with ties to organizations campaigning to boycott the Jewish state. The Commission is so biased against Israel from the outset that it became the first such UN investigative body ever to be condemned by the US, Canada, UK, and Germany. Still, member-state funding for the open-ended diplomatic assault continues.

3 ABBAS + PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY

Abbas goes to Berlin to feed a monstrous lie many Europeans want to believe, then doubles down on pay to slay Jews



As it should, Germany has the toughest laws to deal with Holocaust denial. After all, it was Nazi Germany that planned and executed the genocidal 'Final Solution' that murdered six million innocent Jews during the Shoah. It was therefore appropriate when **German prosecutors opened a four month investigation** into a statement that declared that Israel had committed "50 Holocausts" against the Palestinians. This was from the same person whose doctorate questioned **whether 6 million Jews had actually been murdered.**

The culprit? Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas who made that statement while standing alongside German Chancellor Scholz during a press conference in Berlin. Chancellor Olaf only condemned the remarks the next day. "Mahmoud Abbas accusing Israel of having committed '50 Holocausts' while standing on German soil is not only a moral disgrace, but a monstrous lie," former Israeli PM Yair Lapid reacted. "History will not forgive him." But millions of Europeans do believe the Israel=Nazi big lie.

A poll released in December concluded that **one out of three Norwegians believes that Israel treats the Palestinians as badly as the Nazis treated the Jews.** An earlier **poll in Germany confirmed** similar views in their country.

Meanwhile, Abbas has doubled down on his Palestinian Authority (PA) rewards program for murdering and maiming Jews. In one ghoulish example of this depraved policy, the PA raised the salary of **terrorists who murdered 9 people at Hebrew University** on the 20th anniversary of the attack. Apparently, Abbas has no reason to fear that donor nations will turn off the financial spigot. So the pay to slay Jews budget line continues to swell as the number of Israelis are killed and injured.

IRAN'S STATE-SPONSORED HATE

Iran's Center for Jewish Studies lays groundwork for genocide of the Jews



The world continues to be riveted by the unprecedented protests against the Ayatollah Khamenei, led by the women of Iran. Protests have now surpassed 100 days and have extended to 280 cities, left over 750 fatalities and an estimated 30,000 detentions across the country. The regime's thugs have murdered and raped, showing no mercy to their fellow Iranians who are demanding their dignity and freedom. In an unprecedented move, concerned Jewish leaders **told members of their community not to gather in their synagogues** as protests continue to rage. And the increasingly nervous **regime broadcast a detailed threat to annihilate Israel with massive missile strikes if the Jewish State attempts to destroy Tehran's nuclear capabilities.**

In keeping with the best traditions of the Nazis and Soviet Communists, the Iranian Regime's serial genocidal and theological hatred of Jews is led by a so-called Center for Jewish Studies.



Iran's Center for Jewish Studies has published more than 1,000 blatantly anti-Semitic essays weaving a toxic mix of theology, historic hatred of Jews, and anti-Israel screeds on behalf of the nefarious Khamenei regime. This includes a version of the 'Blood Libel,' that defames Judaism, alleging that roots of "child-killing" by Zionists in Palestine lie in the Torah. Another article has Jewish kabbalists agreeing that Satan is their guiding light. Still another alleges Mohammed and his daughter, Fatima, were killed by Jews (Muslim tradition says both died natural deaths). Iran's Center for Jewish Studies is run by a Muslim cleric, Kayvan Ezzati, who has posted articles that Jews are behind pedophilia, drug trafficking, prostitution, and all Iran's problems.

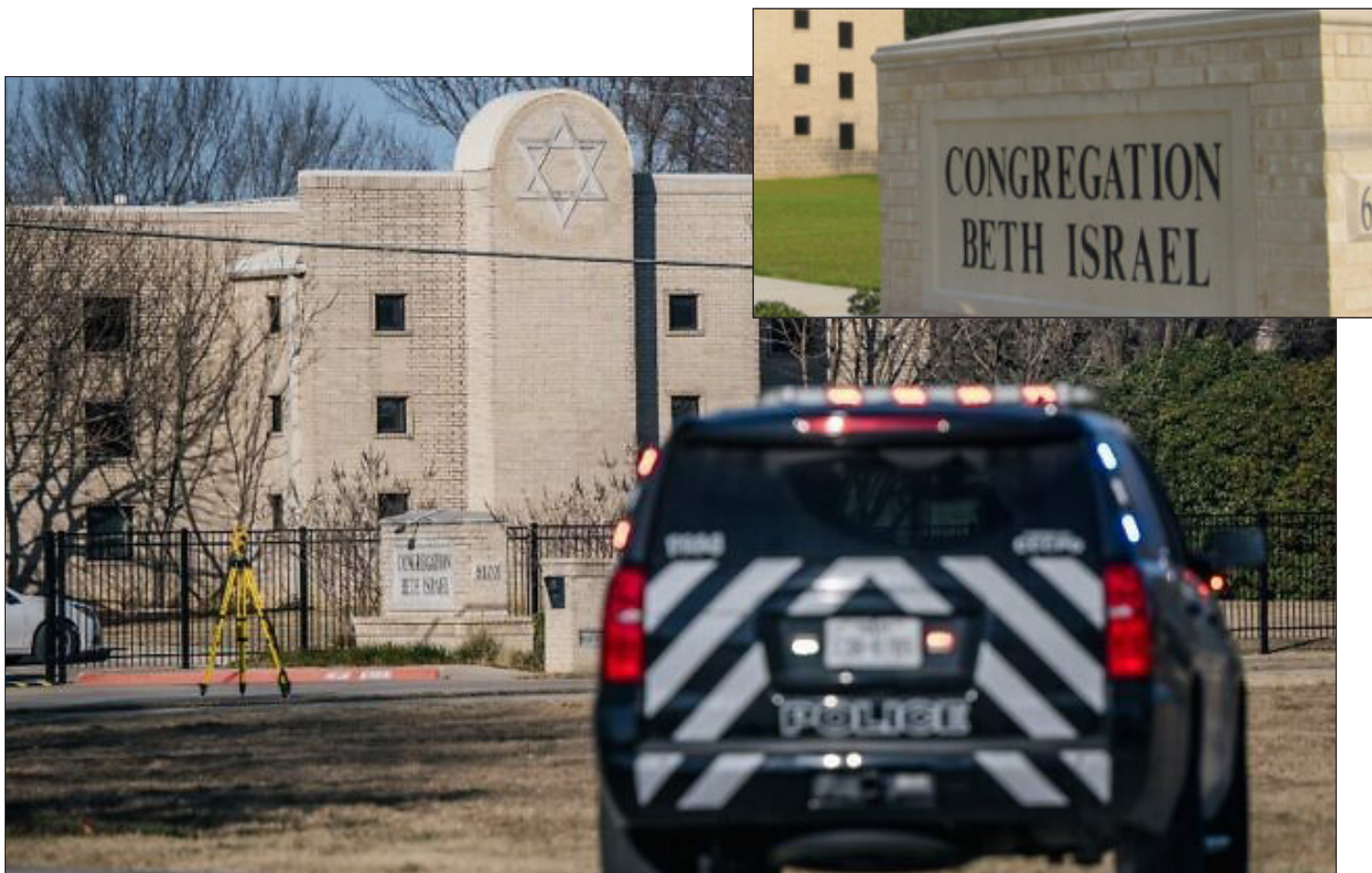

5 HOSTAGES TAKEN AT TEXAS SYNAGOGUE

Shocking hostage-taking at Texas Sabbath synagogue service



Attacks on synagogues and other Jewish institutions, including swastikas, shots fired, and vandalism, have occurred on both sides of the Atlantic. Every attack leaves a community shaken.

On Shabbat morning January 15th, 2022, an incident took place on American soil that was carried out by a foreign terrorist who traveled thousands of miles to target a small synagogue in Colleyville, Texas, a suburb in the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

Malik Akram, an armed British Pakistani, took four hostages at Congregation Beth Israel. Akram was demanding the release of an al Qaeda operative convicted of attempted murder of Americans. Hours later, Akram was killed by an FBI rescue team and none of the hostages were injured. The incident left many unanswered questions: Who was behind the attack? Who funded Akram's flight? Who selected the target? Why a synagogue? That hostage-taking drama combined with skyrocketing anti-Semitic hate crimes led the Simon Wiesenthal Center to urge FBI Director Christopher Wray to establish a Special Taskforce on Anti-Semitism. Director Wray himself would acknowledge that **63% of all religion-based hate crimes in America targeted Jews — just over 2% of the US population.** While the FBI has stepped up its interaction with the SWC and other Jewish groups, it has yet to commit the expertise and resources to help thwart the growing anti-Semitism plaguing the nation.

ASSAULTS ON JEWS: EMPATHY BUT NOT ENOUGH ACTION

Words alone won't stem violent targeting of Jews in the heart of Western democracies

NEW YORK:

Crime is way up in New York City including hate crimes. Physical attacks on openly identifiable Orthodox Jews in New York City are the highest they've been in decades. A scourge of anti-Semitic attacks are plaguing the nation's largest city. Ultra-Orthodox Jews, especially in Jewish neighborhoods in Brooklyn, have been beaten, spat upon, their hats torn off their heads, and cursed in a barrage of attacks over the last year.

In November, two men, Christopher Brown, and Matthew Mahrer, were arrested by the FBI/NYPD Joint Terrorism Task Force and the NYPD Counterterrorism and Intelligence Bureau for threatening an armed attack on a synagogue. The two were taken into custody before they could act on their plan to murder members of the local Jewish community. They were found carrying several weapons including a Glock semi-automatic handgun, and a ghost gun with an extended 30-round magazine and laser sight. "This was not an idle threat," New York Mayor Eric Adams charged, "this was a real threat."



Also in November, FBI Director Christopher Wray spoke in New York and confirmed that 63% of religiously based hate crimes in the country are motivated by anti-Semitism — targeting a group that makes up just 2.4% of the US population. (see #5)

The attacks continue. In December, a Jewish man was struck from behind in Central Park by an assailant while shouting "Kanye West 2024." The 63-year-old victim fell to the ground, chipping a tooth and sustaining a broken hand.

A week earlier, a New York man was arrested and charged with firing a BB gun at an ultra-Orthodox Jewish man and his seven-year-old son. The two victims were in front of a kosher grocery store in Staten Island. The alleged assailant is in custody charged with a hate crime.

Also in December, New York Mayor Adams reiterated that attacks on Jews will not be tolerated, insisting that there will no longer be any plea bargaining for perpetrators. It is not clear if there are enough police to deal with the tsunami of hate crimes, and if in the no-bail era the political will exists in New York officials to create real accountability and deterrence against anti-Semitic hate crimes.

ASSAULTS ON JEWS: EMPATHY BUT NOT ENOUGH ACTION

CHICAGO:***Hate crimes soar 71%. Main targets—Jews and Blacks***

Parents and students at a Jewish girls' school for parent-teacher conferences witnessed a Chicago man **threaten to "burn a rabbi in a gas oven"** just days before the Chanukah festival. The man was arrested and held on bail. Other incidents involving obviously religious people occurred in Jewish neighborhoods during 2022.

LONDON:***No justice no peace***

At a Chanukah celebration with Jewish leaders London Mayor Sadiq Khan declared that Jewish Londoners shouldn't hide in face of anti-Semitic attacks. The problem is the attacks continue. London's Shomrim Society reports that **a thirteen year old Jewish girl was threatened** by

a ranting bigot screaming: "I'm Adolf Hitler & I will kill Jews" while making a "gun gesture" towards her with his umbrella.



London Mayor Khan told the *Jewish Chronicle* that the new Metropolitan police commissioner understands the "ripples of hate" that come out of anti-Semitic incidents in London. The mayor, speaking at the lighting of the Trafalgar Square menorah on the second night of Chanukah also said that both City Hall and the Metropolitan police continue to have "zero tolerance" despite a spate of anti-Semitic incidents in London this month.

"Zero tolerance" has not yet stemmed anti-Semitic attacks. A Jewish worshiper outside a synagogue was pelted with eggs from a moving car, and in the city's Stamford Hill section where many ultra-Orthodox Jews live, two Jewish girls, ages 12 and 13, on their way home from school were confronted by five teenagers who held a knife to their faces. Just days earlier, Jewish children at a park were harassed. Two other 11-year-olds were attacked in Stamford Hill by a group of teens. One victim was punched while the perpetrator laughed, and his friends threatened to attack them again. In July, a woman wielding a wooden stick approached a Jewish woman and declared, "I am doing it because you are Jew," while striking her over the head and pouring liquid on her.

A man who traveled two hundred miles to perpetrate three anti-Semitic attacks on Orthodox Jews is using similar tactics that helped gain the release of violent French anti-Semites, by claiming he was on cocaine and magic mushrooms at the time of the attacks. Abdullah Qureshi, 29, told the court he suffers from hallucinations and paranoia.

Mayor Khan's kind words of solidarity are small solace for the Jewish community confronted with the shocking decision of authorities not to prosecute pro-Palestinian activists who drove through a Jewish neighborhood in London during the last confrontation between Hamas and Israel, screaming they would rape Jewish women and girls.

The reassuring words of political leaders has not been backed by serious counter-measures to protect Jewish Londoners.

ASSAULTS ON JEWS: EMPATHY BUT NOT ENOUGH ACTION**GERMANY:**

Hate crimes continue. Jews ask, "Do we have a future in this country?"

In November, a German Iranian man was arrested for multiple Molotov cocktail attacks on synagogues. The latest attack took place at a synagogue in Bochum. A witness, also a German-Iranian, told police that the suspect tried to recruit him for the attack and assured him he would be allowed to return to Iran without repercussions.

In the western city of Essen, several bullets were shot at a rabbi's home and former synagogue. Commenting on the attack, German Justice Minister, Marco Buschmann tweeted, "Antisemitism must have no place.It is our duty to protect Jewish life."

In Berlin, two attacks on Jewish train riders took place on the same day. One victim, Ariel Kirzon, the Orthodox rabbi who leads the community of Potsdam, a Berlin suburb, said he was speaking Hebrew on a cell phone outside a commuter rail station when a man pushed him and insulted him with anti-Jewish slurs, calling him a – schrecklicher Scheissjude – a terrible shitty Jew. Later that September day, another Jew was insulted and beaten at another commuter station. In October, German Federal police reported that 1,555 anti-Semitic incidents had already taken place in the country in 2022.

Jewish leaders are deeply worried over the continuing hate crimes and the fact that two of Germany's anti-Semitism czars are themselves accused of anti-Semitism. Also troubling is Germany's continuing close economic ties with the Holocaust-denying, genocide-threatening Iranian regime.

Meanwhile, one prominent German Jewish leader, Semen Gorelik, chairman of a Jewish community in the state of Brandenburg announced in a blistering public letter that he is **leaving Germany for Israel and urged German Jews to follow suit due to the rising tide of anti-Semitism in the country.**

IVORY TOWER - ANTI-SEMITISM ON CAMPUSES**Academia weaponized against Israel, Zionists, and Jews**

For generations, young American Jews saw a college education as a crucial stepping-stone to knowledge, a job, and a future in the American dream. For some, that dream has come at a terrible price. They opt to remain silent or worse, cave to woke anti-Israel mobs. For others, the price is too high to pay and leave the school.

A study by the AMCHA Initiative uses three markers to identify anti-Israel/anti-Jewish animus at the nation's universities.

1. The “denigration” of Jewish students
2. Jews feeling pressured to “suppress” their identity
3. Jews feeling forced to “redefine” their Jewish identity to make it acceptable (for example, declaring that they are not pro-Israel)

AMCHA reports that there were more incidents of anti-Semitism at **Harvard University** – the pinnacle of elite American universities – than at any other US university in 2022. Selected examples of anti-Semitic conduct at Harvard include the tearing down of Harvard Hillel posters, anti-Israel stickers attached to tubs of kosher hummus in the dining halls, and the posting of anti-Harvard College Israel Trek signs. Attempts were also made to disrupt pro-Israel speakers. A swastika was found in an undergraduate dorm, the school paper endorsed the anti-Semitic, anti-Israel Boycott Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement, and Harvard’s Palestine Solidarity Committee erected a wall with Holocaust imagery replete with anti-Semitic statements.

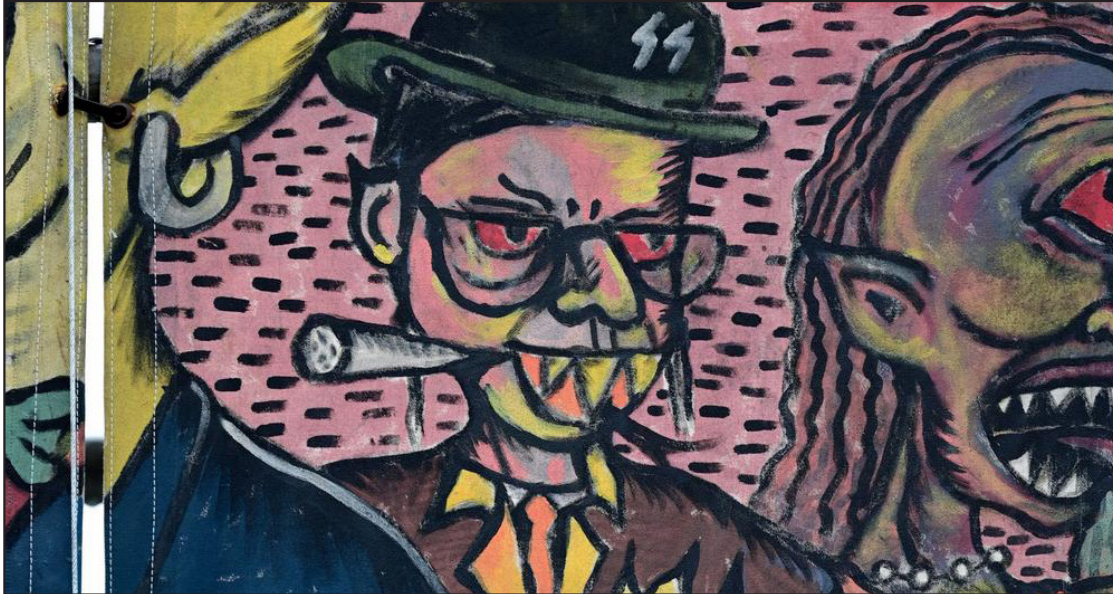
- **Rutgers University** professor Noura Erakat delivered a lecture at the University of Illinois supporting an armed campaign to destroy the state of Israel. Incredibly, the lecture was sponsored by the university’s Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

- **City University of New York (CUNY)** provided first and second generation American Jewish students and faculty with a welcoming environment for intellectual growth. In 2022, a toxic environment beset Jewish students and professors leading to lawsuits by Jewish professors, hearings at the New York City Council and a US Department of Education investigation. A joint Hillel-ADL survey finds that one-third of the Jewish students at CUNY experienced on-campus anti-Semitism, leading some to drop out.

- Meanwhile, the US Department of Education has also launched an investigation of nine student groups at **University of California Berkeley’s** law school. The groups amended their by-laws to prohibit Zionists or anyone who supports Israel from speaking at events on campus. In the last century such behavior was associated with Nazis or Communist regimes. In fact, Berkeley was at the vanguard of the Free Speech movement in the 1960s and 70s. Now, Zionism is verboten, and Zionists are demonized and shunned at Berkeley.

- At the **University of Arizona**, Professor Thomas Meixner was shot and killed in October, because his killer, graduate student Murad Dervish, mistakenly thought Meixner was Jewish. Dervish shot Meixner after making numerous anti-Semitic threats against his life. The threats were reported to authorities, but not enough was done to prevent the murder.

DOCUMENTA ART***Documenta 15 - German government-funded elite art show displays anti-Semitic tropes***

As the SWC Top Ten list confirms, the stain of anti-Semitism is spreading rapidly through social media. In Germany, the taboos surrounding Jew-hatred continue to be breached, fueled by elements of the German government and artistic elite who supported the inclusion of anti-Semitic tropes at the prestigious *Documenta* by a group supporting the boycott of Israel.

Visitors to *Documenta*, a prestigious art show that takes place every 5 years, were exposed to ugly and pernicious caricatures of Jews.

In one area, an Israeli soldier with a pig's head and wearing a Star of David on his scarf is displayed. Also shown, is a Jew with peyot (side curls), a hat with SS symbols, and a cigar. The scandal went on for months. The mural was removed, but officials organizing *Documenta* were widely condemned by civic organizations and politicians for allowing the mural to appear in the first place. And if all that wasn't enough, a brochure for another proposed exhibit shows an Israeli soldier with the face of a monkey wearing a Star of David. Claudia Roth, Germany's culture minister stated at the time, "In my view, this is antisemitic imagery."



Nancy Faeser, Germany's Interior Minister, recently declared that anti-Semitism in her country persists "not only on the fringes, but also at the heart of our society." You can thank the machinations of the cultural elite, peddlers of Israel=Apartheid, Israel=Nazis, the failure of German authorities to go beyond logging hate crime numbers to fighting anti-Semitism, all contributing to an increasingly bleak future for Germany Jewry. There are Germans who believe they can mock, denigrate, threaten, and attack Jews with impunity. It is up to the rest of Germans to prove them wrong.

BLACK HEBREW ISRAELITE (BHI) MOVEMENT

“Hitler knew who the real Jews were”



Extremists of the **Black Hebrew Israelite (BHI) movement** have become emboldened since Kanye West's recent anti-Semitic rants and Kyrie Irving's tweet sharing an anti-Semitic movie which introduced the movement's ideology to millions of people via the mainstream media and over 70 million social media followers. Hundreds marched outside the Barclays Center, home of the NBA Brooklyn Nets which counts Kyrie Irving among its stars, in support of Irving who had been sanctioned by the NBA. BHI theology maintains that Blacks, and sometimes Hispanics and Native Americans - not the Jews - are the true descendants of the Biblical Israelites. Hundreds more gathered near one of Brooklyn's largely Jewish neighborhoods where they could be heard chanting, "We are the real Jews" and "Time to wake up." In a video taken at the scene, members of the "Israel United in Christ" sect are heard chanting in unison: 'It's time to wake up'. I've got good news for you, we are the real Jews." Their chants echoed a striking similarity to the core belief of the white supremacist Christian Identity movement - namely that the real children of Israel are white European gentiles, and that Jews are Satanic imposters.

Most chilling were the words chanted in New York, the city with the largest Jewish population, in another video outside Brooklyn's Barclays Center, following West's interview on conspiracy theorist Alex Jones' *InfoWars* show where West praised Hitler and denied the Holocaust. A BHI Sicarii speaker outside the Barclays Center agrees with West. "Hitler knew who the real Jews were" that a nearby Jew was "the seed of the devil" that "fake Jews" would go into slavery, and he was glad the Holocaust happened.

While these extremist views are currently held by a very small subsection of society, thanks to West they have had unprecedented access to the mainstream media and millions via social media. **The group's hateful ideology had already spawned violent and deadly attacks targeting American Jews.**

10 TELEGRAM

A cesspool of anti-Semitism normalizing hate

Telegram, with more than half a billion users, is one of the world's most widely turned-to messaging apps. Telegram, however, is also a cesspool of Jew-haters and other extremists who are generally barred from other internet platforms. SWC researchers have identified over 400 Telegram groups and channels, including the racist, anti-Semitic manifesto authored by the terrorist who murdered 51 people in New Zealand in 2019.

Periods of uncertainty, social crisis and dislocation such as the continuing Covid-19 pandemic, are fertile soil for conspiracy theories. Many conspiracy theories blame a small group of people, often history's usual scapegoat - the Jews. Telegram channels brazenly promote anti-Semitic tomes such as the "Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion" as well as stereotypical images of hooked-nosed Jews along with exhortations to murder them. Neo-Nazi and white supremacist groups openly organize on this platform, sharing propaganda to recruit new people to their movements. SWC's complaints to Telegram's officers and pleas to delete hate and violence-inciting materials continue to fall on deaf ears.
